I-295 northbound Exit 45 to close this weekend in Westampton for reconstruction Ramp from Rancocas Road eastbound to I-295 southbound will also be closed

(Trenton) - New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the weekend closure and detour of I-295 northbound Exit 45 and the ramp from Rancocas Road eastbound to I-295 southbound in Westampton, Burlington County.

Beginning at 10 p.m., tonight, Friday, October 4 until 5 p.m. Sunday, October 6, NJDOT's contractor, Richard E. Pierson, Inc. will close I-295 northbound Exits 45A and 45B for concrete repair. In addition, the ramp from Rancocas Road eastbound to I-295 southbound also will be closed to facilitate full-depth reconstruction of the ramp. The following signed detours will be in place:

I-295 northbound Exit 45A to Rancocas Road eastbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on I-295 northbound wishing to take Exit 45A to Rancocas Road eastbound will be directed to continue on I-295 northbound
- Take Exit 47B to CR 541 northbound towards Burlington
- Keep right and take the ramp to I-295 southbound
- Take Exit 45A to Rancocas Road eastbound

I-295 northbound Exit 45B to Rancocas Road westbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on I-295 northbound wishing to take Exit 45B to Rancocas Road westbound will be directed to continue on I-295 northbound
- Take Exit 47B to CR 541 northbound towards Burlington
- Keep right and take the ramp to I-295 southbound
- Take Exit 45B to Rancocas Road westbound

Rancocas Road eastbound to I-295 southbound detour

- Motorists traveling on Rancocas Road eastbound wishing to take the ramp onto I-295 southbound will be directed to continue on Rancocas Road eastbound
- Take the ramp to I-295 northbound
- Take Exit 45B to Rancocas Road westbound
- Keep right and take the ramp to I-295 southbound

The work is part of a \$10.3 million state-funded project to repave five miles of I-295 in Mount Laurel and Westampton. It also includes paving on segments of Route 130 in Cinnaminson and Pennsauken, and segments of Route 38 in Moorestown and Mount Laurel.

Variable message signs are being utilized throughout the project limits to provide advance notification to motorists of traffic pattern changes.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
