Ramps between I-80 eastbound and Route 17 southbound closed and detoured overnight this week in Hackensack Closures needed for curb and inlet work for pavement preservation project

(Trenton) -

New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the I-80 Local eastbound Exit 64 ramp to Route 17 southbound will be closed and detoured on Tuesday night, November 5 and the Route 17 southbound ramp to I-80 eastbound will be closed and detoured on Wednesday night, November 6 in Hackensack, Bergen County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. Tuesday, November 5 until 5 a.m. the next day, NJDOT's contractor, D'Annunzio & Sons, Inc., is scheduled to close and detour the I-80 Local eastbound ramp to Route 17 southbound for concrete curb and inlet work. The following detour will be in place:

I-80 Local eastbound Exit 64 ramp to Route 17 southbound detour

(From 9 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 5 until 5 a.m. Wednesday, Nov. 6)

- Motorists on I-80 Local eastbound wishing to take Exit 64 to Route 17 southbound will be directed to continue on I-80 eastbound to the next exit
- Take Exit 65 Green St/Teterboro/S. Hackensack
- Turn right at the end of the ramp onto North Street
- Turn left on Green Street
- Turn left at the traffic signal toward Route 46 west
- Take the second exit for Route 17 South

Beginning at 9 p.m. Wednesday, November 6 until 5 a.m. the next day, NJDOT's contractor, D'Annunzio & Sons, Inc., is scheduled to close and detour the Route 17 southbound ramp to I-80 Local eastbound for concrete curb and inlet work. The following detour will be in place:

(From 9 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 6 until 5 a.m. Thursday, Nov. 7)

• Motorists on Route 17 southbound wishing to get onto I-80 Local eastbound will be directed to continue on Route 17

- Take the Terrace Ave/Polifly Rd exit and Stay in the left lane
- Turn left at the traffic signal onto Terrace Ave
- Cross over Route 17 and stay in the right lane
- Take the ramp to I-80 eastbound

The work is part of a \$15.2 million pavement preservation project on I-80 that will improve portions of the highway in both the eastbound and westbound directions in Parsippany-Troy Hills, Hackensack, Teterboro, South Hackensack, Ridgefield Park Village, Bogota, and Teaneck. The project is expected to be completed in the fall of 2020.

Variable message signs and lane closure signs will be utilized throughout the project limits to provide advance notification to motorists of all traffic pattern changes associated with the bridge replacement project.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
