Route 1 at Garden State Parkway overnight lane closures required as bridgework advances in Woodbridge Travel lanes will remain open during construction

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures on Route 1 in both directions tonight, and next week, as the Route 1 at Garden State Parkway (GSP) bridge deck replacement project advances in Woodbridge.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, November 15 until 6 a.m. tomorrow morning, and continuing next week from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. the next day, on Monday, November 18, through Thursday, November 21, New Jersey Turnpike Authority's contractor, Northeast Remsco Construction, Inc., will close a lane in both the northbound and southbound directions on Route 1 near the GSP intersection. One lane will remain open in each direction at all times. The closures will allow for bridgework and painting as the project progresses.

The bridge work is part of an ongoing New Jersey Turnpike Authority (NJTA) \$42.7 million deck replacement contract of six non-major Parkway bridges between Old Bridge and Woodbridge, which began in 2015. Additional lane closures during off-peak hours may be necessary until project completion. NJTA has designed the project to advance with temporary lane closures, reopening after each shift. All lanes will be maintained during the morning and evening commutes. For more information on the project, contact the NJTA.
