Route 4 westbound ramp to Route 17 northbound closed and detoured tonight in Paramus One night closure needed for milling and paving

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the Route 4 westbound ramp to Route 17 northbound is scheduled to be closed and detoured tonight for milling and paving in Paramus.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, November 22 until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, November 23, NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Group Inc., is scheduled to close and detour the Route 4 westbound ramp to Route 17 northbound to mill and pave the ramp. The following signed detour will be in place:

Route 4 westbound to Route 17 northbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 4 westbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 17 northbound will be directed to continue on Route 4 eastbound
- Take exit for Ikea Drive/G S Plaza/ U-Turn
- Stay right and take the U-Turn ramp
- Stay in the left lane and turn left at the light onto Route 4 eastbound
- At the light, use the left 2 lanes to turn onto the ramp for Route 4 west
- Take the exit for Rout 17 north

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
