## I-78 express westbound overnight lane and ramp closures for concrete repair in Springfield, Union County Traffic will be diverted onto I-78 local

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane and ramp closures on I-78 express westbound for concrete repairs in Springfield, Union County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, March 13, NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Group, will close all I-78 express westbound lanes from just beyond Vauxhall Road to the Route 24 interchange. All traffic on I-78 express westbound will be diverted onto I-78 local at the crossover ramp.

The ramp from Springfield Avenue southbound to I-78 express westbound also will be closed, and motorists will be directed to use the ramp from Springfield Avenue southbound to I-78 local westbound, which is located just before the express ramp. These closures are necessary for concrete deck repairs on the I-78 express westbound lanes over Route 24.

By 7 a.m., tomorrow, Saturday, March 14, all lanes on I-78 express westbound and the ramp from Springfield Avenue will reopen. The concrete repair work is part of a larger state-funded contract to maintain and repair concrete structures throughout the state.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
