## I-80 eastbound Exit 54 to Minnisink Road to be closed tomorrow for guiderail installation in Totowa, Passaic County Signed detour will be in place

**(Trenton)** - New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced a ramp closure on I-80 eastbound in Totowa as a roadway improvement project advances in Passaic County.

Beginning at 9 a.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, May 6, until 3 p.m., NJDOT's contractor Joseph M. Sanzari, Inc., is scheduled to close and detour the I-80 eastbound Exit 54 ramp to Minnisink Road. The closure will allow the contractor to install guiderail. The following signed detour will be in place throughout the day:

## I-80 eastbound Exit 54 to Minnisink Road detour:

- Motorists traveling on I-80 eastbound wishing to take Exit 54 to Minnisink Road will be directed to take Exit 53 to Route 46 eastbound (which comes before Exit 54)
- Continue on Route 46 eastbound
- Keep right and take the ramp to Riverview Drive/CR 640
- Use the right lane to turn onto Minnisink Road

Advance warning and variable messaging signs are being utilized to provide advance notification to the motoring public of all traffic pattern changes associated with the work.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
