Route 440 southbound ramp to Riverside Drive to be closed overnight this week for bridge maintenance project in Woodbridge Signed detour will be in place

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the ramp from Route 440 southbound to Riverside Drive will be closed and detoured overnight this week as a bridge maintenance project begins in Woodbridge, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Monday, May 18 until 7 a.m. Tuesday, May 19, and repeating each night through Friday, May 22, NJDOT's contractor, Power Concrete, will close and detour the ramp from Route 440 southbound to Riverside Drive in Woodbridge. The closure will allow the contractor to make repairs to the bridge over Route 440. The following detour will be in overnight:

Route 440 southbound ramp to Riverside Drive detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 440 southbound wishing to take the ramp to Riverside Drive will be directed to keep right and continue on Route 440 southbound
- Keep right and take the ramp to Woodbridge Avenue/CR 514 eastbound towards Woodbridge
- Turn right onto Amboy Avenue/CR 501
- Continue on Amboy Avenue/CR 501, which becomes New Brunswick Avenue/CR 616
- Turn right onto Crows Mill Road
- Merge onto Riverside Drive

Variable Message Signs will provide advance notification to motorists of the traffic pattern changes associated with the work. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
