Route 1 ramps to Garden State Parkway north to be closed and detoured overnight this week for paving in Woodbridge One ramp closed and detoured at a time

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the Route 1 ramps to the Garden State Parkway will be closed and detoured overnight this week for milling and paving in Woodbridge.

Beginning at 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. the next day on Tuesday, May 19 and Wednesday, May 20, the New Jersey Turnpike Authority's contractor, Northeast Remsco, will close and detour the ramps from Route 1 northbound and southbound to the Garden State Parkway northbound in Woodbridge for milling and paving. Only one ramp will be closed at a time. The following detour will be in place:

Route 1 northbound ramp to Garden State Parkway northbound:

- Motorists wishing to take the Route 1 northbound ramp to the Garden State Parkway northbound will be directed to continue on Route 1 northbound
- Stay in the right lane and take the Gill Road U-turn exit
- Stay right for Gill Road U-turn
- Immediate merge into the left lanes for Route 1 south to Garden State Parkway north
- Turn left onto Route 1 south
- Take the ramp to the Garden State Parkway north

Route 1 southbound ramp to Garden State Parkway northbound:

- Motorists on Route 1 southbound wishing to take the ramp to the Garden State Parkway northbound will be directed to continue on Route 1 southbound
- Take the Parsonage Road U-turn
- Turn left at the traffic signal onto Parsonage Road
- At the traffic signal, cross Route 1
- Follow the ramp back onto Route 1 northbound
- Stay in the right lane and take the ramp for the Garden State Parkway north

Variable Message Signs will provide advance notification to motorists of the traffic pattern changes associated with the work. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
