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Route 130 will be closed and detoured overnight as Raccoon Creek Bridge replacement completes in Gloucester County Closures will alternate between Route 130 northbound and southbound

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the completion of the Route 130 Bridge over Raccoon Creek replacement in Logan, Gloucester County. In order to restore the road to its final configuration, Route 130 will be closed and detoured overnight for striping.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, June 23 until 2 a.m., NJDOT's contractor, PKF Mark III, Inc., will close and detour Route 130 southbound between Route 322 and Center Square Road to apply final striping, restoring the road to two lanes of traffic from the current one lane. Northbound traffic will not be effected during these hours. By 2 a.m. Wednesday morning Route 130 southbound will reopen with two lanes of traffic.

At 2 a.m. Wednesday, June 24 until 6 a.m., Route 130 northbound will be closed and detoured to apply final striping that will restore the road to its final configuration. Southbound traffic will not be effected during these hours. By 6 a.m. Thursday morning there will be two lanes of traffic on Route 130 northbound increasing it from the current single lane. The following detours will be in place overnight:

Route 130 southbound Detour:

(From 9 p.m., Tuesday, June 23 until 2 a.m.)

- Motorists traveling on Route 130 southbound will be directed to take Route 322 eastbound to I-295 southbound
- Take I-295 southbound to Exit 10/Center Square Road/CR620
- Take Center Square Road/CR620 to Route 130 southbound

Route 130 northbound Detour:

(From 2 a.m. Wednesday, June 24 until 6 a.m.)

- Motorists traveling on Route 130 northbound will be directed to turn right onto Center Square Road/CR620
- Take Center Square Road/CR620 to I-295 north
- to Exit 11 B/Route 322 west back to Route 130

The \$53 million federally-funded Raccoon Creek Bridge replacement and pavement rehabilitation project began in June 2016 and was constructed in stages. The Route 130 southbound bridge over Raccoon Creek was completed in 2018. The Route 130 northbound bridge is now complete.

Portable Variable Message Signs are being utilized to provide advance notification to the motoring public of all traffic pattern changes associated with the work. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
