## I-80 westbound Exit 37 to close overnight for a bridge maintenance project in Morris County Three lanes will be closed on I-80 westbound

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures and a ramp closure on I-80 westbound tonight as a bridge maintenance project begins in Rockaway, Morris County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Wednesday, July 1, until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Thursday, July 2, NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, is scheduled to close and detour I-80 westbound Exit 37 in Rockaway, Morris County. Three lanes on I-80 westbound in the vicinity of Exit 37 also will be closed, with one lane of traffic maintained overnight. These closures will allow the contractor to mill and pave the bridge deck over CR 513/Green Pond Road. The following signed detour will be in place overnight:

## I-80 westbound Exit 37 to CR 513/Hibernia/Rockaway detour:

- Motorists traveling on I-80 westbound wishing to take Exit 37 to CR 513/Hibernia/Rockaway will be directed to continue on I-80 westbound
- Take Exit 35A towards Dover
- Merge onto CR 661/Mount Hope Avenue
- Turn left onto the ramp to I-80 eastbound
- Take Exit 37 to CR 513/Hibernia/Rockaway

If work is completed early, the road will reopen sooner. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
