## Route 133 eastbound overnight lane closures and detours begin in East Windsor, Mercer County Overnight detours in place as for milling and paving work

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures and detours on Route 133 between CR 571 and Route 33 as a pavement preservation project advances in East Windsor, Mercer County.

Beginning at 8:30 p.m. tonight, Monday, July 13, until 6:30 a.m. the next day and continuing Monday through Friday for several weeks, NJDOT's contractor, Earle Asphalt Company is scheduled to close Route 133 eastbound between CR 571 and Route 33 in East Windsor for milling and paving.

Upon completion of paving Route 133 eastbound, work will continue in the westbound direction. NJDOT will provide more information in advance of any future closures. The project will have no impact on traffic using the NJ Turnpike Exit 8/Route 33 Corridor. The following Route 133 eastbound overnight detours are scheduled to begin tonight and continue next week, Monday through Friday nights.

## Route 130 southbound to Route 133 eastbound detour

- Motorists traveling on Route 130 southbound wishing to take Route 133 eastbound will be directed to continue on Route 130 southbound
- Turn left onto CR 571/Stockton Street
- Turn left onto Route 33/North Main Street
- Turn right onto Franklin Street to stay on Route 33 eastbound back to Route 133

## Route 130 northbound to Route 133 eastbound detour

- Motorists traveling on Route 130 northbound wishing to take Route 133 eastbound will be directed to turn right onto CR 571/Stockton Street, which is before Route 133
- Turn left onto Route 33/North Main Street
- Turn right onto Franklin Street to stay on Route 33 eastbound back to Route 133

## Princeton Hightstown Road or Windsor Center Drive to Route 133 eastbound detour

- Motorists traveling on Princeton Hightstown Road or Windsor Center Drive wishing to take Route 133 eastbound will be directed to continue on Princeton Hightstown Road eastbound
- Turn left onto Route 33/North Main Street
- Turn right onto Franklin Street to stay on Route 33 eastbound back to Route 133

The \$4.6 million state-funded project will repair, preserve and restore the pavement to improve safety and enhance ride quality for motorists on approximately seven miles of Route 133 in both directions between CR 571 to Route 33 in East Windsor, Mercer County.

The work will include milling and paving on Route 133 and resurfacing on all the ramps. The project is scheduled to be completed in the fall of 2020.

Variable Message Signs are being used to provide advance notification of all traffic pattern changes associated with the work. NJDOT will provide more information before any lane closures are scheduled. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
