Route 30/White Horse Pike overnight lane closures required as roadway improvement project begins in Egg Harbor City Closures necessary for utility work

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures on Route 30/White Horse Pike as a roadway improvement project begins in Egg Harbor City, Atlantic County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Monday, July 27 until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, July 28, and continuing daily Monday through Friday, NJDOT's contractor, South State Inc., is scheduled to close one lane on Route 30/White Horse Pike near the 6th Terrace intersection in Egg Harbor City, Atlantic County as part of a moving operation. These closures will allow the contractor to complete utility work. At least one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times. Utility work is anticipated to be complete in Spring 2021.

In addition to overnight lane closures, daytime lane closures may be required between 6 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Thursday.

The \$33 million federally-funded project will rehabilitate approximately 14 miles of Route 30/White Horse Pike between Elwood Road in Mullica Township, Atlantic County through Haddon Avenue in Absecon, Atlantic County. Several traffic signals will be replaced within the project limits, and drainage improvements will be made at various locations. Additionally, the project will reconstruct existing curbs, sidewalks and provide for ADA compliant curb ramps at intersections. The project is anticipated to be complete by Fall 2021.
