Route 3 overnight lane closures tonight as Ridge Road and Orient Way Bridges replacement project advances in Rutherford Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures on Route 3 as the Ridge Road and Orient Way Bridges over Route 3 replacement project advances in Rutherford.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Thursday, August 13, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, NJDOT's contractor, Carbro Contractors Corp., is scheduled to close the left lanes on Route 3 in each direction near the Orient Way Bridge. This closure will allow the contractor to work on the center pier of the Orient Way Bridge. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction overnight.

The federally-funded \$26.7 million project <u>began in February 2018</u> and is replacing both the Ridge Road Bridge and the Orient Way Bridge over Route 3, provide a continuous full-width right shoulder on Route 3 in both directions to help ease congestion, and make improvements to the Polito Avenue and Rutherford Avenue intersection, including traffic signal improvements and ADA compliant sidewalk ramps.

The project is being constructed in five stages and NJDOT is using Accelerated Bridge Construction (ABC) techniques. The entire project is expected to be complete in winter 2020. As the Ridge Road and Orient Way Bridges over Route 3 project advances, NJDOT will provide additional information including ramp or lane closures and detours.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
