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Route 4 eastbound to I-95 northbound/George Washington Bridge to be closed tonight for emergency bridge repairs in Fort Lee I-95 northbound to GWB Lower Level, Palisades Parkway and Route 9W to be closed Thursday night

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced Route 4 eastbound to I-95 northbound/George Washington Bridge will be closed and detoured tonight for emergency bridge repairs in Fort Lee. Tomorrow night, I-95 northbound local lanes to the George Washington Bridge Lower Level will be closed and detoured.

Wednesday, September 16

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Wednesday, September 16 until 5 a.m. tomorrow, NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Group, will close Route 4 eastbound to I-95 northbound/George Washington Bridge with all traffic directed to Exit 72. The emergency repairs are necessary to remove loose concrete from under the Route 1&9/Route 46 westbound bridge over I-95 and Route 4. The bridge will remain open.

Motorists on I-95 northbound taking the ramp to the George Washington Bridge Lower Level or Palisades Parkway and Route 9W are advised to use caution and slow down as two out of three lanes under the Route 1&9/Route 46 bridge will be closed.

Expect congestion and delays in the area of Fletcher Avenue and Kelby Street in Fort Lee. The following detour will be in place:

Route 4 eastbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 4 eastbound will be directed to take Exit 72 Route 9W north/Route 1&9 and Route 46 south/ Fort Lee/Palisades Parkway
- At the Fletcher Avenue traffic signal, use the center or right lane to continue straight onto Kelby Street
- Stay left and take the ramp to I-95 eastbound to the George Washington Bridge

Thursday, September 17

Beginning at 9 p.m. tomorrow, Thursday, September 17 until 5 a.m. Friday, September 18, I-95 northbound to the George Washington Bridge Lower Level and Exit 72 to the Palisades Parkway/Route 9W/Fort Lee will be closed and detoured. All traffic on I-95 northbound will be directed to stay left for the George Washington Bridge Upper Level.

Motorists on Route 4 eastbound to I-95/George Washington Bridge are advised to use caution and slow down as the left lane under the Route 1&9/Route 46 bridge will be closed. The following detour will be in place:

I-95 northbound Exit 72 to Palisades Parkway/Route 9W/Fort Lee detour:

- Motorists on I-95 northbound wishing to take Exit 72 Palisades Parkway/Route 9W/Fort Lee will be directed to stay left for I-95 northbound/George Washington Bridge Upper Level
- Take Exit 73 Route 67/Fort Lee
- At the top of the ramp turn right before the toll plaza
- Turn right at the traffic signal onto Bruce Reynolds Avenue
- Turn right at the traffic signal onto Route 67/Lemoine Avenue
- Continue on Lemoine Avenue, which becomes Route 9W or take the ramp onto the Palisades Parkway
