Route 3 overnight lane closures tonight and Friday as bridge replacement project nears completion in Rutherford One lane in each direction will be maintained overnight

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures on Route 3 in both directions as the Ridge Road and Orient Way Bridges over Route 3 replacement project nears completion in Rutherford.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Thursday, November 5, until 5 a.m. the following day, Friday, November 6, and again Friday night during the same hours, NJDOT's contractor, Carbro Contractors Corp., is scheduled to close the right lane on Route 3 in each direction. These closures will allow the contractor to remove construction barrier near the recently-completed Orient Way Bridge. At least two lanes of through traffic will be maintained at all times overnight.

Additional overnight lane closures may be required on Route 3 in the coming weeks to complete final paving. NJDOT will provide advance notice before any additional lane closures.

The federally-funded \$26.7 million project replaced both the Ridge Road Bridge and the Orient Way Bridge over Route 3. It also provided a continuous full-width right shoulder on Route 3 in both directions to help ease congestion, and made improvements to the Polito Avenue and Rutherford Avenue intersection, including traffic signal improvements and ADA compliant sidewalk ramps.
