## Route 4 westbound ramp to Garden State Parkway southbound overnight closures required as paving project advances in Paramus Signed detour will be in place overnight for several weeks

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight closures on the Route 4 westbound ramp to the Garden State Parkway southbound as a paving project advances in Paramus, Bergen County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Thursday, November 19, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Friday, November 20, and repeating Monday through Friday for several weeks, the New Jersey Turnpike Authority's Contractor, Conti Enterprises, is scheduled to close the ramp from Route 4 westbound ramp to the Garden State Parkway southbound. This closure will allow the contractor to mill and pave the ramp. The following signed detour will be in place overnight:

## Route 4 westbound ramp to Garden State Parkway southbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 4 westbound wishing to take the ramp to the Garden State Parkway southbound will be directed to continue on Route 4 westbound
- Keep right and take the ramp to Paramus Road southbound
- Merge on Paramus Road southbound
- Take the ramp to the Garden State Parkway southbound

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
