Pattenburg Road/CR 614 Bridge over I-78 to be closed next week in Hunterdon County Detour required near Exit 11 for bridge repairs in Union Township

(Trenton) – The New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) today announced a week- long closure and detour of the Pattenburg Road/CR 614 Bridge over I-78 next week for bridge repair work in Union Township, Hunterdon County.

Beginning at 12 p.m., Monday, November 30, until 4 p.m., Monday, December 7, NJDOT's contractor, Berto Construction Inc., will close the Pattenburg Road/CR 614 Bridge over I-78. This closure will allow the contractor to make repairs to the bridge. Access will be maintained over the bridge for emergency vehicles as necessary. The following signed detours will be in place:

I-78 westbound and Pattenburg Road/CR 614 southbound Detour

- Motorists using I-78 westbound Exit 11 wishing to cross over I-78 to CR614/Pattenburg Road will be directed to take Route 173 eastbound
- Turn right onto Perryville Road/CR 625 southbound and cross over I-78
- Turn right onto Frontage Road
- Bear right at the fork to stay on Frontage Road
- Turn left onto Pattenburg Road

I-78 eastbound and Pattenburg Road/CR 614 northbound Detour

- Motorists using I-78 eastbound Exit 11 and wishing to cross over I-78 to Route 173 will be directed continue straight at the traffic signal onto Baptist Church Road, which becomes Frontage Road
- Keep left at the fork to continue on Frontage Road
- Turn left on Perryville Road/CR 625 northbound to cross over I-78
- Make a left onto Route 173 westbound back to Pattenburg Road
