Landing Lane Bridges northbound over Raritan River/D&R Canal closed for emergency repairs in New Brunswick Southbound traffic will be maintained from Piscataway to New Brunswick

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the Landing Lane Bridges over the Raritan River and Delaware & Raritan Canal were closed to northbound traffic this afternoon for emergency repairs in New Brunswick, Middlesex County.

Beginning at approximately 4 pm today, the Landing Lane Bridges northbound over the Raritan River and D&R Canal were closed for emergency repairs to the Bridge over the D&R Canal. This closure will allow NJDOT's Contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, to repair potholes and damage to the bridge deck. The bridges will remain open to southbound traffic traveling from Piscataway towards New Brunswick. Landing Lane will be closed to northbound traffic at Easton Avenue. The following signed detour is in place until further notice:

Landing Lane Bridges northbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Landing Lane in New Brunswick wishing to cross the river to Piscataway will be directed to turn right onto Easton Avenue
- Turn left onto Hamilton Street, which becomes Johnson Drive
- Turn left onto Route 27/Albany Street
- Cross the river and stay in the left lane
- Turn left onto River Road
- Take River Road back to Landing Lane

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
