Route 22 westbound lane closures for emergency bridge deck repairs in Union Township Expect heavy congestion or plan alternate route

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the left and center lanes on Route 22 westbound at Route 82/Morris Avenue were closed this afternoon for emergency bridge repairs in Union Township, Union County.

Beginning at approximately 2:45 p.m. today, the left and center lanes on Route 22 westbound at Route 82/Morris Avenue were closed for emergency repairs to the Bridge over Route 82. This closure will allow NJDOT's Contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, to repair potholes and damage to the bridge deck. The lane closure is expected to continue into Saturday. Motorists should expect heavy congestion on Route 22 and the Garden State Parkway South exit 140B.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
