Route 20/McLean Boulevard southbound ramp to Route 4 eastbound to close Monday for barrier curb removal in Paterson Signed detour will be in place

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the ramp from Route 20/McLean Boulevard southbound to Route 4 eastbound will be closed and detoured Monday in Paterson, Passaic County.

Beginning at 9 a.m. Monday, May 17 until 3 p.m., NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, is scheduled to close the Route 20/McLean Boulevard southbound ramp to Route 4 eastbound in Paterson, Passaic County. This closure will allow the contractor to remove barrier curb that was installed last month as part of a drainage improvement project. The following signed detour will be in place:

Route 20/McLean Boulevard southbound ramp to Route 4 eastbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 20/McLean Boulevard southbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 4
 eastbound will be directed to continue on Route 20/McLean Boulevard southbound
- Take the ramp to I-80
- Keep left towards I-80 eastbound/Elmwood Park/New York
- Merge onto I-80 eastbound
- Take Exit 61 towards CR 507/Garfield/Elmwood Park
- Turn left onto River Drive/CR 507
- Use the left lane to take the ramp towards I-80 westbound/Route 20 (which comes before the I-80 overpass)
- Take Exit 60 to Route 20 northbound/Hawthorne
- Merge onto Route 20/McLean Boulevard northbound
- Keep left and take the ramp to Route 4 Eastbound/New York

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
