## Pfeiffer Boulevard/Waltrous Avenue ramp to Route 440 northbound to be closed tonight in Perth Amboy Closure required for bridge deck and joint repairs

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the ramp from Pfeiffer Boulevard/Waltrous Avenue to Route 440 northbound will be closed tonight as a bridge maintenance project advances in Perth Amboy, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, May 18 until 7 a.m. Wednesday, May 19, NJDOT's contractor, Power Concrete, is scheduled to close the ramp from Pfeiffer Boulevard/Waltrous Avenue to Route 440 northbound/Outerbridge Crossing/Staten Island. This closure will allow the contractor to complete bridge deck and joint repairs on the Pfeiffer Boulevard Bridge over Route 440. The following singed detour will be in place:

## Pfeiffer Boulevard ramp to Route 440 northbound detour:

- Motorists on Pfeiffer Boulevard/Waltrous Avenue wishing to take the ramp to Route 440 northbound will be directed to keep left and continue on the ramp towards Route 440 southbound
- Merge onto Route 440 southbound
- Take the exit ramp for New Brunswick Avenue/Woodbridge
- Turn left onto New Brunswick Avenue
- Turn right onto Florida Grove Road
- Turn right onto the ramp to Route 440 northbound

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
