## Route 46 eastbound lane closure and traffic shift required as interchange improvement project advances in Clifton One lane will be closed overnight

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced an overnight lane closure and a traffic shift on Route 46 eastbound as the Route 3/Route 46 Improvement Project advances in Passaic County.

Beginning at approximately 10 p.m. tomorrow, Friday, June 18, until 7 a.m. Saturday, June 19, NJDOT's contractor, Union Paving & Construction Co., Inc., is scheduled to close one lane on the Route 46 eastbound connector road to Route 3 eastbound in Clifton. This closure will allow the contractor to install construction barrier and restripe the roadway to prepare for a traffic shift. One lane of traffic will be maintained overnight.

By 7 a.m. Saturday, both lanes on Route 46 eastbound will reopen, and traffic will be shifted to the north onto the newly-paved Route 46 eastbound lanes to Route 3 eastbound. This traffic shift will allow the contractor to demolish the old ramp from Valley Road to Route 46 eastbound.

The \$189 million federally-funded Contract B portion of the Route 3, Route 46, Valley Road and Notch/Rifle Camp Road Interchange Improvements project\_includes the realignment and widening of Route 46, as well as the construction of wider shoulders, acceleration, deceleration, and auxiliary lanes. At the Route 3/Route 46 interchange, a three lane Route 3 section will replace the existing two lane connections, and Route 46 will be realigned to better converge with Route 3. The new interchange includes four new bridge structures, a new signalized intersection, and a new multi-lane roundabout. This work is anticipated to be complete in 2024.

Contract A, which was completed in fall 2019, included the construction the new Great Notch Road, a new bridge over Route 46 from Great Notch Road to Clove Road, three signalized intersections, and two single-lane roundabouts parallel to Route 46 westbound to remove local traffic from the state highway.
