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Route 1&9 northbound Express lanes to be closed and detoured tonight in Elizabeth

Detour necessary for overhead sign structure replacement

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the Route 1&9 northbound Express lanes will be closed and detoured tonight for overhead sign structure replacement work in Elizabeth.

Beginning at 11 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, June 22 until 5a.m. tomorrow, NJDOT's contractor Ferreira Construction, will close and detour the Route 1&9 northbound Express lanes at North Avenue in Elizabeth, with all traffic shifted to the Local lanes. The closure is necessary to remove and replace an overhead sign structure before Route 22.

In addition, beginning at 9 p.m. tonight until 5 a.m. tomorrow, the left lane on Route 1&9 Express southbound will be closed, and beginning at 10 p.m. tonight until 5 a.m. tomorrow, the right lane on Route 1&9 Local northbound will be closed beginning near Haynes Avenue.

Route 1&9 Local northbound is scheduled to have intermittent 15-minute closures overnight to allow for the removal of the existing sign structure and installation of the new sign structure.

This work is part of a \$9 million regional contract to replace 15 overhead sign structures in north Jersey. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
