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Route 4 left lane closed in both directions for emergency bridge deck repairs in Englewood Expect heavy congestion or plan alternate route

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the left lane on Route 4 in both directions is closed just east of Route 93/Grand Ave in Englewood for emergency repairs to the bridge over Broad Avenue in Englewood, Bergen County.

Beginning at approximately 9 a.m. today, the left lanes on Route 4 in both directions were closed for emergency repairs to the Bridge over Broad Avenue in Englewood. At least one lane in each direction on Route 4 will remain open during construction. Broad Avenue remains open.

This closure will allow NJDOT's Contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, to remove loose concrete under the bridge and reconstruct a portion of the deck. In order to make the repair, the center median on Route 4 will be removed. Once the deck is repaired, the median will be replaced. The lane closures are expected to continue through Saturday afternoon.

Motorists using Route 4 to get to or come from the George Washington Bridge should expect heavy congestion and may want to consider using I-80 as an alternate route.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
