Route 22 lane and ramp closures required for utility work in Hillside, Union County Closures required Friday and next week

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced several days of lane and ramp closures on Route 22 for utility work in Hillside, Union County.

Friday, October 29

Beginning at 9 a.m. Friday, October 29 until 3 p.m., PSE&G is scheduled to close the ramp from Route 22 eastbound to Hillside Avenue in Hillside, Union County. This closure is required for utility pole removal and installation. The ramp from Hillside Avenue to Route 22 eastbound will remain open. The following signed detour will be in place:

Route 22 Eastbound to Hillside Avenue detour

- Motorists traveling eastbound on Route 22 wishing to take the ramp to Hillside
 Avenue will be instructed to exit right at Bloy Street, which comes before Hillside
 Avenue
- Turn right on Bloy Street
- Turn left onto Long Avenue
- Turn left onto Central Avenue
- Turn left onto North Broad Street back to Hillside Avenue

Wednesday, November 3 through Friday, November 5

Beginning at 9 a.m. Wednesday, November 3 until 3 p.m., and continuing daily through Friday, November 5, the ramp from Route 22 eastbound to Hillside Avenue is scheduled to be closed and detoured for utility pole installation. The right lanes on Route 22 also will be closed in both directions near ramp. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction at all times.
