## Route 17 northbound overnight closure required this weekend for priority bridge repairs in Hasbrouck Heights, Bergen County Signed detour will be in place

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that Route 17 northbound will be closed and detoured overnight near the Route 46 overpass this weekend as a priority bridge repair project continues in Hasbrouck Heights Bergen County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tomorrow, Friday, October 29, until 5 a.m. Monday, November 1, NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, is scheduled to close Route 17 northbound near the Route 46 overpass in Hasbrouck Heights. This closure will allow the contractor to demolish and remove the balustrades on the bridge carrying Route 46 westbound over Route 17 northbound. Demolition work is expected to resume again next weekend. The following signed detour will be in place overnight:

## Route 17 northbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 17 northbound will be directed to keep left and take the ramp towards Route 46 eastbound/Palisades Park
- Merge onto Route 46 eastbound
- Keep right and take the ramp towards Green Street/Hackensack
- Turn right onto Green Street
- Turn right onto the ramp to Route 46 westbound
- Merge onto Route 46 westbound
- Keep right and take the ramp towards Route 17 northbound/Paramus
- Merge onto Route 17 northbound

If work is completed early, the road will reopen sooner. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
