Route 22 lane closures required tomorrow for priority repairs in North Plainfield, Somerset County Closures required to repair concrete median

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures on Route 22 for priority repairs in North Plainfield, Somerset County.

Beginning at 10 a.m. tomorrow, Thursday, November 4, NJDOT's contractor, Konkus Corp., is scheduled to close the left lane on Route 22 in both directions between Grove Street and Newton Street in North Plainfield. These closures will allow the contractor to install construction barrier, creating a work zone to repair the concrete median that was damaged during Tropical Storm Ida. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in both directions at all times. The closures are anticipated to remain in place through Thursday, November 11.

If work is completed early, the road will reopen sooner. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
