## Route 22 ramp closures required Thursday for bridge deck work in Hillside, Union County Closures will remain in place for 24 hours

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced ramp closures on Route 22 for bridge deck work in Hillside, Union County.

Beginning at 7 a.m. Thursday, November 11 until 7 a.m. the following morning, Friday, November 12, the ramp from Route 22 eastbound to Hillside Avenue and the ramp from Hillside Avenue to Route 22 eastbound in Hillside are scheduled to be closed. These closures are required to apply sealant to the bridge deck over Route 22. The following signed detours will be in place:

## Route 22 Eastbound to Hillside Avenue detour

- Motorists traveling eastbound on Route 22 wishing to take the ramp to Hillside
  Avenue will be instructed to exit right at Bloy Street, which comes before Hillside
  Avenue
- Turn right on Bloy Street
- Turn left onto Long Avenue
- Turn left onto Central Avenue
- Turn left onto North Broad Street back to Hillside Avenue

## Hillside Avenue ramp to Route 22 eastbound detour:

- Motorists wishing to take the Hillside Avenue ramp to Route 22 eastbound will be directed to take North Broad Street south
- Turn right on Central Avenue
- Turn right on Long Avenue
- Turn right on Bloy Street
- Take the ramp onto Route 22 eastbound

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
