I-287 northbound lane and ramp closures required for bridge deck repairs on New York Thruway/I-87 southbound Motorists should expect delays approaching New York

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane and ramp closures on the I-287 northbound ramp to the New York State Thruway/I-87 southbound as the New York State Thruway Authority (NYSTA) begins a bridge deck repair project.

Beginning at 7 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, November 9, NYSTA's contractor is scheduled to close the right lane on the I-287 northbound ramp to the New York Thruway/I-87 southbound, which is located across the New York State line. The lane is anticipated to remain closed for several weeks while the contractor completes concrete bridge deck repairs. Motorists should expect delays approaching the New York State line.

In addition to the lane closures, the I-287 northbound ramp to the New York Thruway/I-87 southbound is scheduled to be closed and detoured beginning at 9 p.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, November 10 until 6 a.m. the following morning, Thursday, November 11. Motorists are advised to follow the signed detour which will be in place.
