UPDATE

Route 202 northbound and ramps to and from I-80 closed tonight for sign replacement in Parsippany-Troy Hills Closures required to install new overhead sign

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced Route 202 northbound and ramps to and from I-80 will be closed tonight for an overhead sign replacement project in Parsippany-Troy Hills, Morris County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Thursday, January 20, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Friday, January 21, NJDOT's contractor, Sparwick Contracting, is scheduled to close and detour Route 202 northbound/Littleton Road just past the split with Frontage Road, which includes the ramp onto I-80 westbound. The ramp from Route 202 northbound onto I-80 eastbound will remain open. In addition the I-80 eastbound Exit 42C ramp to Route 202 northbound will be closed and detoured. The closure is necessary to remove an overhead sign structure and install a new overhead sign structure on Route 202 northbound before the ramp to I-80 westbound. If work is completed sooner, the road and ramps will reopen earlier. The following detours will be in place:

Route 202 northbound detour/I-80 eastbound Exit 42C detour:

- Motorists on I-80 eastbound wishing to take Exit 42C to Route 202 northbound will be directed to continue on I-80 eastbound; and
- Motorists on Route 202 northbound will be directed to take the ramp onto I-80 eastbound
- Take I-80 eastbound Exit 43 to I-287
- Stay in the left lane for I-287 northbound
- Continue on I-287 northbound
- Take Exit 43/Interval Road/Mountain Lakes
- Turn right to Route 202 northbound; or
- Turn left onto Intervale Road to take Route 202 southbound to Parsippany-Troy Hills

Route 202 northbound to I-80 westbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 202 northbound wishing to take the ramp onto I-80 westbound will be directed to take the ramp to I-80 eastbound
- Take I-80 eastbound Exit 43 to I-287
- Stay in the left lane for I-287 northbound
- Continue on I-287 northbound
- Take Exit 43/Interval Road/Mountain Lakes
- Turn right to Route 202 northbound; or
- Turn left onto Intervale Road
- Turn left onto Route 202 southbound
- Follow Route 202 southbound to Littleton Road

- Turn right onto Littleton Road to stay on Route 202 southbound
- Stay left and take the ramp to I-80 westbound

The work is part of a \$7 million state-funded project to replace sign structures in various locations on I-280, Route 202, Route 19, and Route 1&9/Route 46 in four counties throughout North Jersey.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
