Route 18 lane closures for emergency roadway repairs in East Brunswick, Middlesex County Construction expected to affect the evening commute

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures on Route 18 northbound and southbound for emergency roadway repairs in East Brunswick, Middlesex County.

At approximately 10 a.m. today, Friday, April 1, **the left lane on Route 18 southbound** was closed for an emergency sinkhole repair near Tices Road in East Brunswick. At least two lanes will be maintained while repairs are being made.

At approximately 11 a.m. today, Friday, April 1, the **left two lanes on Route 18 northbound** will be closed for an emergency repair to a damaged roadway joint just past Milltown Road. At least one lane will be maintained while the work is being done.

Motorists are advised to use caution and slow down through the work area so crews can safely make the repairs. The work is expected to be completed this evening and will affect the evening commute. Plan ahead and consider alternate routes.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
