Route 21 northbound to be closed and detoured tonight for Garden State Parkway Bridge project in Clifton Closure necessary for survey work

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials announced Route 21 northbound will be closed and detoured tonight as a Garden State Parkway Bridge project advances in Clifton, Passaic County.

Beginning at 11:59 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, May 10, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, May 11, Route 21 northbound will be closed and detoured before it merges with Route 46 eastbound in Clifton. The closure is necessary to complete survey work. The following detour will be in place:

Route 21 northbound detour:

- All traffic on Route 21 northbound will be directed to take Exit 13 to Ackerman Avenue/Botany Village/Garfield
- Turn right at the traffic signal onto Ackerman Avenue
- Cross the bridge and turn left onto River Drive
- Follow River Drive to the ramp onto Route 46 eastbound; or
- Take the ramp to Route 46 westbound to Route 20 northbound

The work is part of the New Jersey Turnpike Authority's superstructure replacement and widening project of the Garden State Parkway Bridge over the Passaic River, Route 46 and River Drive.
