## Route 1 northbound lanes and on-ramp from Grandview Avenue eastbound closed tonight in Edison

Closures necessary for manhole repairs

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane and ramp closures on Route 1 northbound tonight to reset a manhole in Edison, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Thursday, May 19, until 6 a.m. Friday, May 20, NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Group, is scheduled to close two right lanes on Route 1 northbound will be closed just before Grandview Avenue. In addition, the ramp from Grandview Avenue eastbound to Route 1 northbound will be closed and detoured. The following detours will be in place:

## **Grandview Avenue westbound ramp to Route 1 northbound detour:**

- For motorists on Grandview Avenue westbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 1 northbound will be directed to continue on Grandview Avenue westbound
- Turn left onto Woodbridge Avenue, which becomes Main Street/CR 514
- Turn left onto Ford Avenue
- Turn right onto Route 1 northbound

The work is part of a \$6.1 million state-funded maintenance contract to repair stormwater facilities and manholes at various locations in seven counties throughout Central Jersey. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
