POSTPONED

Green Street northbound and southbound ramps to Route 46 westbound to be closed this weekend in Teterboro Closures required for curb and guiderail installation

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the Green Street northbound and southbound ramps to Route 46 westbound planned for this weekend **has been postponed due to weather**. NJDOT will provide advance notice of any future closures once it has been rescheduled.

The \$8.8 million federally-funded Route 46, Bergen Boulevard to Main Street roadway improvement project will resurface approximately two miles of Route 46 in Lodi, Hasbrouck Heights, and Teterboro, Bergen County. The project also includes the installation of ADA-compliant curbs and ramps, as well as traffic signal upgrades. The project is expected to be complete in summer 2022.
