Route 17 lane and shoulder closure next week for curb work in Ramsey, Bergen County Closures necessary as part of developer project

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane and shoulder closures next week on Route 17 northbound for curb work in Ramsey, Bergen County.

Beginning at 9 a.m. Monday, July 11, until 3 p.m., and continuing daily through Friday, July 15, NJDOT's contractor, Joseph M. Sanzari, Inc., is scheduled to close the right auxiliary lane and shoulder on Route 17 northbound between Airmount Avenue and Williams Drive. The closures are necessary for curb work as part of a developer project. Access to Williams Drive and businesses will be maintained.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
