Route 1 and Milltown Road/CR 606 interchange ramps to be closed tonight in North Brunswick Closures necessary for guiderail installation and pavement preservation

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced ramp closures at the Route 1 and Milltown Road/CR 606 interchange tonight for guiderail installation and pavement preservation in North Brunswick, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Friday, July 22, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, July 23, NJDOT's contractor, Earle Asphalt Company, is scheduled to close and detour the Route 1 southbound ramp to Milltown Road eastbound and the Milltown Road/CR 606 westbound ramp to Route 1 southbound. The closures are necessary for guiderail installation on the Milltown Road/CR 606 Bridge over Route 1. The following detours will be in place:

Route 1 southbound to Milltown Road eastbound:

- Motorists on Route 1 southbound wishing to take the ramp to Milltown Road eastbound/Milltown will be directed to continue on Route 1 southbound
- Take the next exit ramp to Carolier Lane/Route 130 southbound/Camden/CR 171 South/New Brunswick
- Stay left on the ramp to Route 130 southbound/Camden
- Turn left onto Georges Road/CR 171, which becomes Route 130 southbound
- Turn left onto Carolier Lane
- Turn right to continue on Milltown Road/CR 606 eastbound, which becomes Main Street

Milltown Road westbound to Route 1 southbound:

- Motorists on Milltown Road westbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 1 southbound/Trenton will be directed to continue on Milltown Road westbound
- Turn left onto CR 171, which becomes Georges Road
- Turn left to take the ramp to Route 1 southbound/Trenton, <u>before Georges Road/CR 171</u> <u>become Route 130</u>

This work is part of the \$8.7 million federally-funded Milltown Road/Main Street (CR 606), Bridge Over Route 1 project. Work includes the installation of guiderails, as well as milling and paving, on the Milltown Road/CR 606 bridge over Route 1 in North Brunswick, Middlesex County.
