Market Street lanes closed for emergency bridge repairs to Route 1 overpass in Trenton Expect congestion and delays during evening commute

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced two lanes on Market Street eastbound will be closed shortly for emergency bridge repairs to the Route 1 overpass in Trenton.

NJDOT's contractor, Sanzari Inc., will be closing two out of three lanes on Market Street eastbound under the Route 1 overpass to remove loose concrete and make repairs. The ramp from Market Street to Route 1/the Trenton Transit Center/S. Clinton Avenue north is not affected at this time and remains open. Route 1 is not affected and all lanes remain open at this time. Once work on the eastbound lanes is complete, Market Street westbound lanes will be closed for repairs to the overpass.

The work is expected to affect the evening commute. Motorists are advised to use caution, slow down and expect delays.
