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I-80 eastbound Exit 4C ramp to Route 94 northbound to be closed and detoured tonight in Knowlton, Warren County Overnight closures required for concrete deck repairs

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the I-80 eastbound Exit 4C ramp to Route 94 northbound will be closed and detoured tonight for concrete deck repairs in Knowlton, Warren County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Friday, September 9, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, September 10, NJDOT's contractor, Mount Construction Co., Inc., is scheduled to close the I-80 eastbound Exit 4C ramp to Route 94 northbound to make concrete deck repairs on the Route 94 Bridge over I-80. In addition, both lanes on Route 94 northbound will be closed on the Route 94 Bridge over I-80. The ramp from Route 46 westbound to I-80 westbound will remain open during construction. The following detours will be in place:

I-80 eastbound Exit 4C to Route 94 northbound detour:

- Motorists on I-80 eastbound wishing to take the Exit 4C ramp to Route 94 northbound/Blairstown will be directed to continue on I-80 eastbound
- Take Exit 12 to CR 521 to CR 519/Blairstown/Hope
- Stay left on the ramp to turn left onto CR 521/Hope Blairstown Road
- Take the ramp to I-80 westbound
- Take Exit 4 A-B-C to Route 46 eastbound to Route 94 northbound/Columbia/Blairstown
- Stay left to take Exit 4C-A to Route 94 northbound/Blairstown

Route 94 northbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 94 northbound will be directed to take the ramp to I-80 eastbound/Netcong/New York City, just before the Route 94 Bridge over I-80
- Take Exit 12 to CR 521 to CR 519/Blairstown/Hope
- Stay left on the ramp to turn left onto CR 521/Hope Blairstown Road
- Take the ramp to I-80 westbound
- Take Exit 4 A-B-C to Route 46 eastbound to Route 94 northbound/Columbia/Blairstown
- Stay left to take Exit 4C-A to Route 94 northbound/Blairstown

The work is part of a \$21.6 million state-funded maintenance project to repair concrete structures at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
