Route 206 northbound shoulder and lane closure tonight as intersection project advances in Burlington County Closure necessary to implement traffic shift

(Trenton) – The shoulder and right turning lane on Route 206 northbound at the intersection of Monmouth Road are scheduled to be closed tonight Tuesday, February 21 from 8 p.m. until 7 a.m. Wednesday, February 22 in Springfield, Burlington County.

The overnight closures are necessary to install concrete barrier and implement a traffic shift to create a work zone in the shoulder. One lane of traffic will be maintained during construction. By 7 a.m. Wednesday, the shoulder and turning lane will be closed with traffic shifted to the left for approximately two months for drainage and utility work.

This work is part of \$6.3 million federally-funded intersection improvement project that will make drainage, access, and ADA improvements at the intersection of Route 206, Monmouth Road and Juliustown Road in Springfield, Burlington County.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
