I-78 westbound Express lanes to be closed tonight for bridge deck replacement in Union Township, Union County I-78 westbound Local left lane also to be closed tonight

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that I-78 westbound Express will be closed tonight in Union Township, Union County. In addition, the left lane on I-78 westbound Local will be closed during construction.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Friday, February 24, until 7 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, February 25, NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Inc., is scheduled to close all lanes on I-78 westbound Express from milepost 51.4 to milepost 50.6. The closure is necessary to make bridge deck repairs to the Springfield Avenue/Route 124 Bridge over I-78. Motorists traveling on I-78 westbound Express will be shifted onto the I-78 westbound Local lanes at the crossover ramp for Route 24 westbound to I-287/Springfield/Morristown.

In addition, the left lane on I-78 westbound Local will be closed between mileposts 51.4 and 50.6 overnight at the same times. The lane closure is necessary to allow traffic on I-78 westbound Express to safely merge onto I-78 westbound Local. At least two lanes will be maintained on I-78 westbound Local during construction.

The work is part of a \$5 million state-funded maintenance project to repair bridge infrastructure at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.
