(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the right lane on Route 168 northbound is closed at Narbeth Avenue for emergency gas main repairs in Haddon Township, Camden County.

From 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. beginning today, Tuesday, February 28, PSE&G's contractor will close the right lane on Route 168 northbound at Narbeth Avenue to repair gas main joints. Work will continue daily during the same times for approximately seven days until the repairs are completed.

Motorists are advised to slow down and use caution when driving through the work zone. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
