Route 208 northbound shoulder to be closed as culvert replacement project advances in Wycoff, Bergen County Closure necessary for guiderail replacement

(Trenton) – The right shoulder on Route 208 northbound was closed today, Friday, April 28, between Cedar Hill Avenue and mile post 6.2 as a culvert replacement project advances in Wycoff, Bergen County. The shoulder is expected to remain closed for approximately three weeks for guiderail replacement. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays.

The \$3.9 million federally-funded project will replace the existing culverts on Route 208 northbound and southbound between mile post 6.2 and 6.4. The project also includes guiderail replacement. Work is expected to be complete in the summer of 2025.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
