Route 20/McLean Boulevard southbound ramp to I-80 eastbound to be closed tonight in Paterson Closure necessary for bridge deck repairs

(Trenton) – The ramp from Route 20/McLean Boulevard southbound to I-80 eastbound is scheduled to be closed beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Friday, May 5 until 4 a.m. Saturday, May 6, to make concrete deck repairs to the ramp in Paterson, Passaic County. The following detour will be in place:

Route 20/McLean Boulevard southbound to I-80 eastbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 20/McLean Boulevard southbound wishing to take the ramp to I-80 eastbound will be directed to stay right and take the ramp to I-80 westbound/Del Water Gap
- Take the ramp to Exits 58B/A to Madison Avenue/Paterson/Clifton
- Stay left to continue on I-80 westbound/23rd Avenue
- Take the ramp to Exit 58A to Madison Avenue southbound/Clifton
- Stay left to go past Exit 58A
- Stay left to take the ramp to I-80 eastbound

The work is part of a \$22.6 million state-funded maintenance project to repair concrete structures at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.
