Route 130 overnight lane closures this week for bridge repairs in Burlington and Mercer counties At least one lane will be maintained

(Trenton) – A single lane on Route 130 northbound is scheduled to be closed tonight on the Route 130 Bridge over Crosswicks Creek in Bordentown, Burlington County and Hamilton, Mercer County. In addition, varying lane closures are scheduled on Route 130 in both directions tomorrow night through Thursday night on the Route 130 Bridge over Crafts Creek in Mansfield and Florence, Burlington County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Monday, May 8, until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, May 9, the left lane on Route 130 northbound will be closed <u>on the Bridge over Crosswicks Creek</u>. The closure is necessary to make bridge joint and concrete repairs. At least one lane will be maintained on Route 130 northbound during construction.

In addition, beginning at 8 p.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, May 9, until 6 a.m. Wednesday, May 10, and continuing on Wednesday and Thursday nights at the same times, a single lane on Route 130 will be closed in each direction on the Bridge over Crafts Creek. Construction on Route 130 southbound is expected to start in the left lane and move to the right lane, as work progresses. Once work is completed on Route 130 southbound, it is expected to move to Route 130 northbound. The closures are necessary to make bridge joint and concrete repairs. At least one lane of traffic will be maintained on Route 130 in each direction during construction.

This work is part of the \$8.9 million federally funded bridge preventative maintenance contract that will make joint and concrete repairs to approximately 41 bridges on Routes 40, 47, and 130 in various locations across Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, Mercer and Salem counties.
