## Route 30 eastbound ramp from Cooper Street lane closure tonight as sign replacement project starts in Camden Closure necessary to install barrier and implement a traffic shift

**(Trenton)** – The Route 30 eastbound ramp from Cooper Street is scheduled to have a lane closure tonight as an overhead sign replacement project begins in Camden.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight Friday, May 12 the left lane of the ramp will be closed to install construction barrier and implement a traffic shift. By 6 a.m. Saturday, May 13, one lane will be open with traffic shifted to the right. This traffic pattern will be in place for approximately four months. Access will be maintained to the ramps to Route 30/New Jersey Turnpike ramp and Tenth Street/North Camden.

Daytime work on the overhead sign structures is scheduled to begin Monday, May 15, and continue daily Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. for approximately four months.

The \$9.3 million state-funded project will replace sign structures on various routes in Bergen, Passaic, Morris, Mercer, Camden, Ocean, Union and Essex counties. The project is expected to be completed in fall 2023.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
