## Route 130 northbound single lane closure tomorrow as intersection and bridge deck project advances in Burlington At least two lanes will be maintained

**(Trenton)** – A single lane on Route 130 northbound is scheduled to be closed tomorrow as the Route 130 intersection and bridge deck improvement project advances in Burlington City, Burlington County.

From 9 a.m. until 4 p.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, May 16, a single lane on Route 130 northbound will be closed between Salem Road and Wood Avenue, and between High Street/CR 541 and Logan Avenue near the Jacksonville Road/East Federal Street intersection in Burlington City. The closures are necessary to place construction barrier and restripe the road to implement a traffic shift. At least two lanes will be maintained on Route 130 northbound during construction.

By 4 p.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, May 16, traffic on Route 130 northbound will be shifted onto the right shoulder, and construction barrier will be placed in the left lane to create a median work zone. The traffic shift is necessary for curb and guiderail replacement.

The \$28.1 million Route 130 Intersection and Bridge Deck Improvements project will mill and pave 8.6 miles of road, repair bridge decks, and make electrical and traffic signal upgrades with Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) equipment at 20 intersections. In addition, the project will install ADA ramps, pedestrian safety devices and upgrade guiderail. The project is expected to be completed in fall 2023.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
