Route 19 northbound ramp to Broad Street to be closed tonight in Clifton, Passaic County Closure necessary for bridge deck repairs

(Trenton) – The ramp from Route 19 northbound to Broad Street is scheduled to be closed beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Thursday, May 25, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Friday, May 26, for bridge deck repairs in Clifton, Passaic County. The following detour will be in place:

Route 19 northbound to Broad Street detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 19 northbound wishing to take the ramp to Broad Street/Clifton will be directed to continue on Route 19 northbound
- Take the ramp to I-80 westbound/Grand Street/Delaware Water Gap
- Stay right to take the ramp to Grand Street
- Turn left onto Grand Street
- Go under Route 19
- Turn left to take the ramp to Route 19 southbound/I-80, just past the overpass
- Stay left to get on Route 19 southbound
- Take the ramp to Valley Road/Clifton/Main Street
- Turn right onto Valley Road/CR 621
- Turn left onto Fenner Avenue, back to Broad Street

The work is part of a \$22.6 million state-funded maintenance project to repair concrete structures at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
