## Route 42 southbound overnight lane closures Tuesday and Wednesday in Bellmawr, Camden County Closures necessary for priority concrete bridge repairs

**(Trenton)** – Route 42 southbound/I-76 eastbound is scheduled to have two lanes closed tonight and tomorrow night for priority concrete bridge repairs in Bellmawr, Camden County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, July 11, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, July 12, the two left lanes on Route 42 southbound/I-76 eastbound are scheduled to be closed near Browning Road in Bellmawr. The closure is necessary to make priority concrete bridge repairs to the ramps carrying traffic from I-295 northbound Exit 26 and I-76 eastbound Exit 1A. At least two lanes of traffic will be maintained on Route 42 southbound/I-76 eastbound overnight, and both exit ramps will remain open.

On Wednesday, July 12, from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. Thursday, July 13, the two right lanes Route 42 southbound/I-76 eastbound are scheduled to be closed near Browning Road in Bellmawr to continue the concrete repairs. At least two lanes of traffic will be maintained on Route 42 southbound/I-76 eastbound overnight, and both exit ramps will remain open.

The work is part of a \$3.9 million state-funded Maintenance Concrete Structural Repair Contract covering seven counties in South Jersey including Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, and Salem counties

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
