I-287 northbound Exit 21A ramp to I-78 eastbound to be closed and detoured tonight in Bedminster, Somerset County Closure needed to pave shoulder and remove barrier

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the I-287 northbound Exit 21A ramp to I-78 eastbound is scheduled to be closed tonight to complete repairs to the ramp in Bedminster, Somerset County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. Friday, November 3 until 6 a.m. Saturday, November 4, the I-287 northbound Exit 21A ramp to I-78 eastbound is scheduled to be closed and detoured. The closure is necessary for final paving of the shoulder and removal of construction barrier. The following detour will be in place:

I-287 northbound Exit 21A ramp to I-78 eastbound Detour:

- Motorists on I-287 northbound wishing to take the Exit 21A ramp to I-78 will be directed to continue on I-287 northbound
- Take Exit 26B/CR 525 north/Mt Airy Road north/Bernardsville
- Stay right to take the ramp to I-287 southbound
- Take Exit 21A to I-78 eastbound
