## I-295 northbound overnight lane closures this week as pavement preservation project begins in Burlington County Closures necessary for concrete slab repair

**(Trenton)** - I-295 northbound is scheduled to have a series of overnight lane closures this week for concrete slab replacement as a pavement preservation project begins in Mount Laurel, Westampton, and Burlington townships in Burlington County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Monday, April 1, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, April 2, and continuing each night through Thursday, April 4, at the same times, lane closures are scheduled on I-295 northbound between the Route 38 interchange in Mount Laurel and Elbow Lane in Burlington for concrete slab repairs. The right lane will be closed beginning at 8 p.m. each night, and the center lane will be closed beginning at 10 p.m. each night.

This work is part of the \$8.8 million federally funded I-295, Route 38 to Elbow Lane Pavement Preservation project that will extend the pavement life, improve safety and enhance ride quality for motorists on approximately six miles of I-295 in Mount Laurel, Westampton and Burlington townships in Burlington County. The project is expected to be completed in fall 2024.
